



The Contractor shall be solely responsible in all manner for customs duty & clearance of all the T&P's to be brought from outside Bangladesh & taking back from Bangladesh to origin country (after completion of work), including completion of formalities such as making applications, preparing/ submitting necessary documentation, etc. to all concerned authorities. All applicable charges in this regard shall be borne by contractor.

NOTE:

- (i) Taxes and Duties shall be as per relevant clause in ITB & COC.
- (ii) The indicated man-month rate shall be inclusive of cost of safety items (as per Section IV), two sets of uniform, consumables, any other overhead, to be provided to each manpower. It shall also be inclusive of profit, insurance of Manpower, COVID-19 SOP/protocols, any left out other overhead cost, etc.
- (iii) Lodging, boarding, transportation and local conveyance of Contractor's staff (manpower) shall be arranged by Contractor at their own cost and shall be inclusive in man month rate.
- (iv) The aforesaid Activity/ price Schedule is for Deployment of 105 nos manpower. However, in case of BIFPCL requirement, the no of manpower may be increased/decreased at the same rate and Terms & conditions.



- (v) Supply of Safety/other items: The contractor shall supply all the safety items to his staff before the start of contract & shall be replaced by the contractor as and when it gets damaged. Agency/vendor shall maintain the quality of safety item as mentioned in specification. If quality of safety item not found acceptable by EIC, it must be replaced immediately by contractor.
- (vi) All employed manpower has to follow COVID-19 SOP/protocols as provided by BIFPCL/GOB.
- (vii) The award shall be on Firm Price Basis. However, adjustments for Changes in Legislation on account of minimum wages & taxes as notified by GoB shall be payable in accordance with Amendment no 01 to Bidding Document and Clause no 38 of Section III respectively.
- (viii) Tenderer/Contractor has to ensure that each category of workers employed in this contract must be paid at least minimum wages as notified by GoB.
